- Reminder, to avoid becoming nervous, stay focused on your goals:
- read and obey all signs/signals,
- monitor your speed-keep under 30 mph in a neighborhood,
- stop at white lines,
- scan intersection traffic 1 sec L-R-C before entering
- stay centered in your lane,
- signal in advance of a turn or lane change 100 ft.

Test: Parallel Parking and backing 20 yards looking back, Neighborhood for 12 turns, and a couple lane changes.

To schedule a DPS road exam at <https://txdpsscheduler.com> or simply Google 'DPS Road Exam' to find the link. I suggest use the Georgetown/Round Rock Mega DPS. In the event you want to pay for DPS Third Party Testing to avoid the delay, Stonepoint is now an Authorized DPS Road Test Examiner, register online at StonepointDS.com. You will still need an appointment at the DPS **to change** the Learners Permit License to a Provisional License removing the B, F restrictions. We have priority appointment setting only at the Georgetown DPS, simply show them your Test Envelope or the Green Certificate and the clerk is supposed to set up an appointment within five days. If you test at the DPS, be sure all your light bulbs are functioning or they will not test you.

Items to take to the DPS for your Road Skills Test - Driver License Applicant

1. Texas Driver Education Certificate for Class 32 Hours and Car (DE-964, the green OR gray half sheet)-If you took the Class online you will need TWO CERTIFICATES, showing classroom completed and car training completed.)
 2. \$16 Provisional License Fee (cash, credit, check, or money order)
 3. Your permit - Student may test after 180 days (181st day-see back of license for Restriction code F) and MUST be age 16.
 4. The DPS Impact Texas **Teen** Driver program certificate of completion (ITTD) (expires after 90 days) >>>see back of this page >
- If testing at the DPS, Proof of residency with a current utility bill or auto insurance statement showing BOTH Parents names (unless divorced) and address. And a bank or mortgage statement showing BOTH Parent names (unless divorced) and address

DPS - TEEN AGES 16-17 DRIVER LICENSE – Distracted Driving Video Course Required

ITTD course is the last step before taking the driving road skills examination. We encourage Parents to view the video also, to become more aware of neglectful-distracted drivers with whom they too are sharing the road with daily.

- Certificate is emailed – print it and Student and Parent SIGN IT. Certificate expires 90 days from completion

Once the **Provisional License is issued**, these **RESTRICTIONS** will apply, and please memorize this list as the DPS Test Evaluator may ask you to recite them.

1. May only have one passenger under age of 21 who is not a family member.
2. May not drive between midnight and 5:00 a.m. unless for: **A.** work, **B.** participate in a school activity, **C.** a medical emergency.
3. Individuals who are under 18 years of age are restricted from using a wireless communication device, including a hands-free device, until they reach the age of 18, except in the case of an emergency. (At age 18, we recommend a Bluetooth called 'Jabra Talk 25'.)
4. No driver of any age may text Behind-the-Wheel in TEXAS. You must pull out of traffic, place car in Park to text.
5. Minors are not allowed to consume alcohol until age 21.
